ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Principal John Klemme will give Volunteer Service certificates to students who have complied with the following criteria:

S The student has completed at least 20 hours of volunteer service to one job at school or one community organization or student service club (only clubs whose purpose is to provide community service are eligible) during the current school year. This should be 20 hours of service to one job or organization, not 5 hours at 4 places.

S This service can be performed on school days, on weekends, or during school holiday breaks; but service done during the summer months is not eligible.

S The volunteer work is non-religious. For example, a student's help with religious instruction is not eligible for recognition, nor is work for a religious youth group. Helping at a church soup kitchen or working for a temple-based social program is eligible, so long as it is at least 20 hours for one organization or purpose.

S The volunteer work is not done as part of another recognition program, such as Boy/Girl Scout badges or awards.

S Additional recognition will be given to students who volunteer more than 40 hours or more than 70 hours with one organization during the current school year.

Note all volunteer work must be completed by June 30, 2010

Students have until June 30, 2010 to complete their volunteer work.

However, students must submit a schedule or plan for the remaining hours to be served after April 16, as indicated on the application. Both hours actually served, and hours intended to be served must be approved by the student's volunteer service supervisor, who may be contacted by the SHS PTA Volunteer Service committee.
